



3. Bregenz, Austria

If you want to "get away" while being close to some popular travel destinations, Bregenz is an ideal choice. This is a beautiful, alpine European town that sits on the edge of Lake Constance. It's only a short trek away from Germany, Switzerland, France, Italy, and Lichtenstein.
